**Question**

*Pedersoli is preparing a sight base for the Whitworth rifles to fit Creedmoor diopters without the need to drill a hole in the wood. The metal base is attached to the tang. Is this acceptable for Whitworth and long range disciplines?*

**Remarks**

*The SAC members agreed that this type of addition is acceptable on target rifles, as it is not offering unfair advantages to the shooter while it helps preserving the value and integrity of original firearms.  
 The method is accepted on both reproductions and originals.*
